A Note From Your Director



GoPro is a brand of high-definition personal cameras, often used in extreme action video photography. They are known for being lightweight, rugged, wearable (head-mounted) or mountable in unusual places such as outside planes, cars, or boats.

The Black Edition features a new 12 MP sensor that is capable of capturing 4K digital video at 15 fps, 2.7K video at 30 fps, 1440p at 48 fps, 1080p at 60fps, 720p at 120 fps and WVGA at 240 fps. The Black edition also includes the Wifi Remote. All three versions of the Hero3 come in a new 30% smaller and 25% lighter package, with WiFi functionality built in.
